To Whom It May Concern:

The reckless and illegal driving of golf carts and other motorized vehicles by individuals cause a serious safety issue for both clients and participants during events on the Mississippi State Fairgrounds.

The use of Golf Carts and ATV's anywhere on the Mississippi State Fairgrounds is restricted and only intended as a means of transportation to get to a destination within the vast 105 acre fairground area. A 12 mph speed limit is imposed throughout the grounds. 5 mph maximum should be observed in areas more crowded with pedestrian or vehicular traffic present.

Only licensed drivers should operate any vehicle while on the Mississippi State Fairgrounds.

The number of passengers per vehicle should be limited to the maximum number as intended for that vehicle. All passengers must be seated. There should be no standing on the back or sides of the vehicle. Patrons on vehicles without seatbelt restraints are encouraged to wear safety helmets/gear.
